These terms and conditions of entry (Terms and Conditions) are designed to enable the 2011 NRMA Gold Medal Challenge Event, Coffs Harbour (the “Ride”) to run smoothly and safely. By registering to participate in the ride the parent / guardian and participant (“Rider”) agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions.

Bicycle NSW means Bicycle NSW Incorporated ABN 26 511 801 801 and includes where appropriate Bicycle NSW’s employees, agents, contractors and officers.

Entry requirements

1. The rider must be registered in the NRMA Gold Medal Challenge prior to registering for the event.
2. The participant must be at least 9 years of age (school year 5).
3. The rider should be confident with riding on public roads and cycle ways and possess good ability to perform essential cycling skills (such as signaling, turning, stopping quickly etc).
4. The riders bicycle should be road worthy and in full working order prior to the ride. If deemed unsuitable Bicycle NSW has the right to refuse participation on the ride.

Acknowledgement and waiver

1. The rider and their parent / guardian acknowledge that cycling can present some inherent risk and that he / she is participating in the ride at his/her own risk.
2. In consideration of Bicycle NSW permitting the Rider to enter and participate in the NRMA Gold Medal Challenge Event, Coffs Harbour, the Rider and Riders parent/guardian hereby releases and indemnifies Bicycle NSW, the sponsors of the Ride and any of their respective representatives from and against all and any claims, suits, demands, liabilities, loss and damage (including indirect and consequential loss), costs, expenses and, interest, whether pursuant to common law or statute, that the Rider may suffer or incur arising from or connected with the Rider’s participation in the Ride including as a result of the negligence, breach of duty, breach of care or other fault or responsibility of Bicycle NSW, the sponsors of the event and any of their respective representatives.

Compliance with laws

1. During the ride the rider must comply with all traffic and road laws and all instruction given by Bicycle NSW or officials representing Bicycle NSW.
2. The rider must wear an Australian standard cycling helmet during the ride while riding a bicycle.
3. Bicycle NSW reserves the right, in its absolute discretion to refuse to allow the rider to participate in the ride or to remove the rider from the ride for breach of the terms and conditions or otherwise if it determines appropriate to do so.

Mode of transport

1. Only standard, human powered bicycles are permitted in the event. Scooters, skateboards and motorized / power assisted bicycles are not permitted in the event.

Preparation and health and safety

1. It is the responsibility of the rider to ensure that they have adequate food and drink for the ride.
2. The rider should be familiar with the details of the event and should only take part if they can confidently ride in public areas (including but not limited to public roads and cycle ways)

Liability and responsibility

1. Bicycle NSW is not liable for any loss, damage of equipment or expense of any kind.
2. Bicycle NSW may, in its absolute discretion and without giving reasons for its decision, accept or refuse an application for registration.
3. If, during the Ride, the Rider becomes ill or is injured, Bicycle NSW will endeavor to arrange medical transport, usually in an ambulance. Any medical transport will be at the Rider's expense. (Bicycle NSW recommends that Riders hold current ambulance service membership and /or health insurance to cover such costs)

Weather

1. Given that the event will be held outdoors it may be necessary to cancel the ride due to bad weather. Bicycle NSW reserves the right to make this decision at any time prior to event. Participants will be contacted and advised of any cancellation. Bicycle NSW is not liable to rider or parent / guardian for any loss, damage, cost of any kind as a result of the cancellation.
