

News from the Board – April

April has seen the succession committee of the Board continue with the process of appointing a new CEO for Bicycle NSW. At the April Board meeting President Jenny Burn reported on progress, including on having received over 90 applications for the position. The succession committee will commence interviews in May.

Interim CEO Elizabeth Hole updated the Board on the work being done by the Bicycle NSW team and Chloe Mason on our response to the Metropolitan Strategy Review and the progress being made on the 2010 Spring Cycle. Liz also advised the Board of the launch of the Bicycle NSW Commuter Challenge and immediately a number of Board Members asked to be included.

Finally, the Board continued its discussion on the strategy for Bicycle NSW (including as to how it can continue to assist the BUGs) and agreed to get together on Sunday 16 May for a whole day planning session. The Board welcomes any thoughts from the membership in this regard."
